Research Management in University and Industry to Establish the Best Match

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Abstract: There is a big difference in research between University and Industry. The research itself looks the same by appearance, but the difference exists because of its own goal; university is a non-profitable organization and industry has to be profitable one. A lot of fundamental and long term researches have been done in industry, but they are for future products or income sources of its company. Under keeping IPR (Intellectual Property Right), new products quick to market are highly required to compete with other companies. On the other hand, a researcher in university has a big freedom and accomplish the research based on his philosophy, but must give a huge impact to industry to make a rich society. I have been engaged in the research of Electronics and Computer Science both in university and industry in Japan for 50 years. By coupling with university and industry research, there is a big chance to lead to a successful story. Based on my experience, I want to present research management to establish the best match for a fruitful future.

Satoshi Goto received the B.E. and the M.E. Degrees in Electronics and Communication Engineering from Waseda University in 1968 and 1970 respectively. He also received the Doctor of Engineering from the same University in 1978. He joined NEC Laboratories in 1970 where he worked for LSI design, Multimedia system and Software as GM and Vice President. From 2002 to 2015, he was Professor, at Graduate school of Information, Production and Systems of Waseda University and now Emeritus Professor at Waseda University and Vice President at E-JUST in Egypt., He served as GC of ICCAD, ASPDAC, VLSI-SOC, ASICON and ISOCC and was a board member of IEEE CAS society. He is IEEE Life Fellow and IEICE Fellow. He has received a number of awards and honors, including Distinguish Achievement Awards from IEICE, the Best paper award from ISSCC, IEEE VLSI Symp. and IEICE, and also Jubilee Medal from IEEE and Life Time Achievement Award from IEEE ISPD. He is Visiting Professor at Shanghai Jiao Tang University, Sun Yat-sen University and Tsinghua University of China and Member of Science Council of Japan.
